

Dr. Edje is a board-certified family physician, chair of the family medicine review committee of the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education and chair of the nominating committee of the American Medical Association's Council on Medical Education. She was on the writing group for the new requirements for family medicine training. She was the Ohio Academy of Family Physicians 2012 Family Physician of The Year. She was president of her class at the University of Michigan Medical School (UMMS) then completed her family medicine training, with honors, before 13 years in private practice.
