

Dr. Elisa I. Choi, MD, MACP, FIDSA, FAMWA (She/Her) is a dual Board-Certified Internal Medicine and Infectious Diseases physician in full-time clinical practice in primary care, HIV medicine, and ID consultation. She is a successful and experienced physician leader, and a Harvard Medical School faculty member who teaches, precepts, and mentors medical students and physician trainees. Dr. Choi is an internationally invited speaker, educator, and published author on topics ranging from infectious diseases, HIV, health disparities, health and gender equity, and clinical quality and performance measurement.

Dr. Choi is a recent past Regent of the Board of Regents of ACP, the immediate past Governor of the Massachusetts ACP Chapter, and a Past Chair of the ACP Board of Governors. Dr. Choi was the first woman, and only Asian American female, elected to serve as Governor of the Massachusetts ACP Chapter in its almost 100-year history, and is the first woman of Asian heritage to be elected as ACP Chair of the Board of Governors. In 2025, she was re-elected to serve a second term on the AMA (American Medical Association) Women Physician Section (WPS) Governing Council and re-elected to serve as Chair of the AMA-WPS. She has been awarded Fellowship in ACP, IDSA (Infectious Disease Society of America), and AMWA (American Medical Women's Association), for her service and national leadership roles in these organizations. Dr. Choi is a member of the ACP delegation to the AMA House of Delegates.

Dr. Choi is a past recipient of the MA ACP Chapter Leadership award and Helen Taussig Women in Medicine Award, the Exceptional Mentor Award and Inspire Award from AMWA, and the Inspiration Award from AMA. Dr. Choi received the ACP 2024 Richard Neubauer Advocate for Internal Medicine Award, which recognizes exceptional contributions to advance ACP's public policy agenda. In 2025, Dr. Choi received additional awards - the prestigious, competitive, and highly selective MACP (Mastership) award from ACP ("MACPs must be highly accomplished persons demonstrating impact in practice, leadership, health policy, or in medical research"), which is a confidential nomination and selection process which does not permit self-nominations. Dr. Choi also received the MA ACP Chapter Laureate Award ("Massachusetts Chapter Laureate Award honors those members of the ACP in Massachusetts who have demonstrated by their example and conduct an abiding commitment to excellence in medical care, education or research, and in service to their community and the ACP".) in the fall of 2025.

Dr. Choi is deeply committed to supporting and developing future physician leaders, particularly women in leadership, and is proud to support the WPLA Winter 2026 session as its Facilitator.
